

## Music Director

Greenland Community Congregational Church, United Church of Christ

The people of Greenland Community Church encourage all to grow in faith through public worship. Music is integral to this experience. We offer our talents to the greater glory of God as experienced by all. We are a caring and nurturing body in community with one another and with Christ.

To this end we ask the Music Director to:

- Work with the Minister and Public Worship Ministry Group in the development and leading of weekly worship and special services such as Christmas Eve, Ash Wednesday and Maundy Thursday ;
- Collaborate with the Minister in the planning of worship (liturgy, hymns, responses, anthems, etc);
- Plan , direct and coordinate the worship music including the church choir and periodic special music, including instrumentalists, and vocalists;
- Play the organ and the piano including prelude, postlude and incidental service music

### Specific Duties:

Select music for and direct rehearsals of the choir (this duty is suspended pending guidance due to COVID 19);

Coordinate the maintenance of the organs and pianos of the church;

Maintain and develop the music library;

Work with all ages as they may participate in the Music program, at the discretion of the Music Director;

Engage a substitute for services where the Music Director will not be available;

Plan and oversee the inclusion of guest musicians in our worship services;

Engage and direct vocal and instrumental musicians where appropriate within the music budget set by the Church;

Accompany rehearsals of guest musicians as needed;

Collaborate with the Public Worship Ministry Group on the administration of the annual budget for music programs;

Collaborate with the minister and the Public Ministry Group on the planning for special events; and

Special Musical performances in addition to worship services when agreed to by the Music Director and the Public Worship Group.

The Music Director shall also provide music at funerals and weddings and other special occasions as agreed and will receive additional compensation for those services from participants and/or families.

Compensation: \$9,000.00 per year with 3 weeks of vacation each year.

Compensation shall increase when the church choir begins rehearsals after the restrictions from COVID 19 are lifted.
