Music Minister Position

St. Christopher's Episcopal Church in Hampstead, New Hampshire is seeking a Music Minister to begin soon to serve this creative, musically open, intergenerational church community in small-town New England.

The Music Minister plays piano/organ, provides for music at part of our 8AM service once a month, regularly leads the music for the 10:15 services and directs one choir rehearsal per week during the program year. The church choir is an amateur choir which delights in joyful heartfelt music. The music minister also meets quarterly with a music committee to plan music for liturgical seasons.

This position requires some adaptability as the COVID pandemic continues and sometimes requires shifts in how music ministry happens in the church. Comfort with being recorded for digital worship services and familiarity with music copyright considerations are preferred. Ability to engage the congregation to actively participate in the music is desired.

The choir customarily practices after the 10:15 service on Sundays. The Music Minister also organizes and provides music for special services such as Christmas Eve and Holy Week and occasional programming. The Music Minister works with occasional children's musical programming as well.

This position Salary range \$11,000- \$12,000 per year depending on experience. It is a 4-5 hour weekly commitment.
