The Director of Music/Organist–Pianist will:

- Provide musical leadership and accompaniment for Sunday worship and special services
- Direct a dedicated choir and help cultivate its continued excellence
- Collaborate with the Pastor to select music that supports thoughtful, inspiring worship
- Foster a creative and inclusive music program that welcomes participation from all ages

Schedule & Compensation

- Part-time (approximately 12 hours per week), year-round position (July 1–June 30)
- We cover 4 work days off for any personal time during the year
- Weekly commitments include:
 - Sunday worship (9:30 a.m.)
 - Thursday evening rehearsal (6:30–8:00 p.m.) September – mid-June
 - Sunday morning rehearsal (8:30–9:15 a.m.) September – mid-June
- Additional services during Advent, Christmas Eve, Lent, Holy Week, and Easter
- Salary commensurate with experience (biweekly, non-benefited)

Qualifications

Required:

- Degree in music or equivalent experience
- Proficiency in both organ and piano, including strong sight-reading skills
- Ability to lead congregational singing with confidence and creativity
- Strong organizational, communication, and interpersonal skills
- Ability to work both independently and collaboratively

Preferred:

- Experience in church music leadership
- Choral directing experience
- Familiarity with a variety of musical styles and improvisation
